The Council Services Officer has provided the following update:-

Ground events:

- Cove Creek Oval – No use.
- Dog Arena Pontville – used each week by Tassie Flying Paws group (dog agility training), limited dog show events.
- Equestrian Area – Increased use over Jan/Feb.
- Ferguson Oval – Matches played each weekend.
- Gunn Oval – Matches played each weekend.
- Thompson Oval – Matches played each weekend.
- Weily Park Oval – Little Athletics and Weily Park Rockers Cricket.
- Cloak Oval – Matches played each weekend.

Halls events:

- Weily Park Hall – Verbal enquiry from Joanne Gallagher, Technobeat requesting if it would be possible for her to lease from Council. Written offer yet to be sent through.
- Civic Centre – Two forums organized by LGAT to be held for upcoming election. 14/2 Lyons Candidate forum, 23/2 Party Leaders forum.
- Old Beach – booked every evening Mon – Thu, fitness, karate and Scouts, playgroups on Wed and Mondays. Consistent use by casual hirers.
- Pontville Hall – Regular hirers, Girl Guides, GKR Karate, Bugeido Karate, Rykuyu Karate. Life without barriers are hiring the hall 2 days per week to run programs on site. Consistent high usage rate.

Other:

- DOSA soccer are keen to use Weily Park as their home ground. FFT have advised Derwent United are not eligible for registration for the coming season.
- Community Blitz funds and assets to be dissolved to other community groups, potentially through a one off grant program.
- Volunteering Tas are looking for nominations for their annual Volunteering Awards.
- Red Cross is undergoing further restructuring in staff and programs, will be presenting at the Feb Brighton Alive meeting.
