Brighton welcomes Park funding promise

Brighton Council has welcomed the State Liberal's commitment of \$500,000 to support the further development of parks in Herdsmans Cove and Gagebrook.

The election commitment is comprised of \$250,000 for a new neighbourhood park in Herdsmans Cove and \$250,000 towards implementing the Cris Fitzpatrick park master plan in Gagebrook.

Brighton Council is pleased these community needs have been recognised and applauds the funding commitment.

Brighton has a strong record of partnering with other tiers of government and groups to deliver improved facilities for our community. The redevelopment of the Cris Fitzpatrick Park and the proposed neighbourhood park in Herdsmans Cove will be the latest in this line of joint initiatives.

Council will consult with the community regarding the location, planning and design of the neighbourhood park in Herdsmans Cove.

The Labor Party has also promised to provide \$500,000 to assist the upgrading of the Cris Fitzpatrick Park in Gagebrook, should it win Saturday's election.
