

Place Based Youth Justice Initiatives Brighton Tasmania Phase 2 Grant Guidelines

Timeline for Phase 2 Grants (this may change/evolve as we progress)

- **17 March:** First Workshop
- **March-April:** Individuals and groups work together to put design pitches
- **April:** Drop-in sessions with DECYP/Council to work on your pitches (dates TBC)
- **May:** Draft Pitches sent to Brighton Alive and Brighton Youth Action Group for feedback
- **Late May:** Pitch feedback considered
- **June:** Final pitches sent to Brighton Alive and Brighton Youth Action Group for voting
- **July:** Grants Assessment Panel makes final decision on successful Pitches

Selection Criteria

- **Alignment to outcomes as created by Brighton Community**
 - The community wants this and is reflected in co-created strategies
 - The pitch demonstrates a partnerships within the Brighton community (e.g. services, people, businesses etc)
- **Sustainability**
 - Pitches demonstrate they will be able to be implemented as proposed (The pitch demonstrates that there are no major gaps/barriers to implementing the project - e.g. further non-secured funding being needed to implement)
- **Long-term impact**
 - Pitches demonstrate the potential for long-term impact beyond the initial funding, e.g. capacity building, utilising seed funding
- **Alignment with objectives of the youth justice reforms**
 - Pitches show alignment with the Youth Justice Blueprint and Model of Care (all group members have been sent this information)
 - Pitches are complementary to the broader service system and include transparent partnerships
- **Having measurable impact**
 - Pitches are able to clearly articulate what outputs (what you will do) and desirable outcomes they are working towards
 - Agree to the monitoring and evaluation processes and time frames
- **Cost**
 - The amount the Pitch is requesting is well reasoned and does not exceed \$20,000

What you cannot apply for: New or existing positions or what is delivered in your role of employment. Applicants who do not have an ABN will need to partner with Brighton Council who will hold your grant funds – please inform Angela Turvey if you intend to submit a pitch – angela.turvey@brighton.tas.gov.au
