

APRIL 2026 COUNCIL MEETING OUTCOMES

Outcomes from the Council meeting held on Tuesday, 21st April 2026:

- Council resolved to open the public open space walkway located between 3 & 4 Kumali Place, Herdsmans Cove.
- Council approved a 3 month rent reduction of 50% for a commercial tenant at Old Beach.
- Council waived the fees for the Butterflies & Boots Gala Ball being held at the Civic Centre on the 30 May and waived the hire fee for this event for the next 3 years.
- Council approved Pontville Park; Remembrance Park; Swan Park and Childs Drive Park as the official park names and will submit these to the Place Name Advisory Panel at NRE.
- Council resolved that the Brighton Agricultural Society are to reimburse Council for rectification works for damage caused to Gunn Oval following the Brighton Show; with an option to pay over a 3 year period.
- Council endorsed the Draft Brighton & Pontville Local Area Plan to be released for community feedback for a 4 week period.
- Council agreed to proceed with the sale of various properties due to outstanding rates in accordance with Section 137(9) of the *Local Government Act 1993*.
